An Act To Improve Cooperative Energy Purchasing for Schools, Towns and Nonprofits

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §5954-A, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1999, c. 231, §2, is amended to read:

1. Authority. In addition to its other enumerated powers, but subject to the limitations imposed under subsection 2, the bank, on behalf of or in partnership with one or more governmental units or nonprofit corporations organized under the 10 Internal Revenue Code, Section 501, may aggregate governmental units and nonprofit corporations fer-the-purpese-of-obtaining electricity-necessary-for-the-daily-operation-of-the-governmental units-or-nonprofit-corporations to purchase in bulk electricity, 14 petroleum products, fuel oil and natural gas.
