COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 983, L.D. 1419, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Regarding Certain Employment-related Matters"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 3.

SUMMARY

This amendment deletes section 3 of the bill, which would have removed the exemption for wages earned as a volunteer emergency medical services worker in the definition of total and partial unemployment in the laws governing unemployment compensation.
