Fiscal Detail and Notes

The establishment of a nonresident lobster license will increase General Fund revenue collected by the Department of Marine Resources by \$3,114 in each of fiscal years 2005-06 and 2006-07. The establishment of these licenses will also increase Other Special Revenue Funds revenue collected by the department by minor amounts.
