SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 530, L.D. 1528, Bill, "An Act To Create a Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences at the University of Maine"

Amend the bill in section 1 in section 9-B in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "shall" and inserting in its place the following: 'is authorized to'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in section 9-B in the first paragraph in the 2nd to the last line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "biosciences" the following: '. If the board establishes a graduate school of biomedical sciences, it must be'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in section 9-B in paragraph A in the first 2 lines (page 1, lines 12 and 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "The Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System shall establish the school" and inserting in its place the following: 'The school must be established'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.

SUMMARY

This amendment authorizes, but does not require, the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System to establish a graduate school of biomedical sciences to educate and train
