COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1303, L.D. 1863, Bill, "An Act To Permit Supplemental Environmental Projects for Forest Practices Violations"

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §8870, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 694, §1, is repealed.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 5 in the first paragraph in the 2nd to 5th lines (page 1, lines 6 to 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "any of the provisions of the laws administered by the bureau, including without limitation a violation of the terms or conditions of any order, rule, license, permit, approval or decision of the bureau" and inserting in its place the following: 'this subchapter or any rule adopted under this subchapter'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 5 in the last paragraph in the 3rd to 5th lines (page 2, lines 12 to 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and are ineligible for certification as tax-exempt pollution control facilities pursuant to Title 36, chapters 105 and 211"

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

This amendment repeals an obsolete effective date. It specifies that the provisions for supplemental environmental projects apply only to violations of the forest practices laws in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, chapter 805, subchapter 3-A. It deletes unnecessary language.
