This amendment amends the definition of "low-alcohol spirits product" to mean a product containing spirits that has an alcohol content of 6% or less by volume. Current law defines a low-alcohol spirits product as a product containing spirits that has an alcohol content of less than 6% by volume.

The amendment also adds language to the bill to clarify that the State Liquor and Lottery Commission establishes the prices of spirits sold in the State. It also removes a reference to state discount liquor stores that were authorized by a section of law that has since been repealed.
