

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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.  
1347, L.D. 1906, Bill, "An Act To Safeguard Maine's Highways"

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Amend the amendment in Part A in section 5 in §2464 in  
subsection 2 by inserting at the end (page 2, line 43 in  
amendment) the following: 'The minimum sentence of imprisonment,  
which may not be suspended, is 5 years.'

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**SUMMARY**

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This amendment specifies that a person who, while knowingly  
operating with a suspended or revoked license, in fact causes the  
death of another person is subject to a minimum term of  
imprisonment of 5 years.
