	the purpose of awarding a contract, give any preference to a

	or by a major substantive rule adopted by the Maine State Housing
10	Authority in accordance with Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

	This bill prohibits the Maine State Housing Authority from
16	giving any preference to a bidder for purposes of awarding a contract unless that preference is specifically authorized by law

or by a rule that is reviewed and authorized by the Legislature.

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
