
12 Amend the amendment in Art. IV, Pt. Third, §20 in the 14th line from the end (page
13 3, line 6 in amendment) by striking out the following: "~~return them to~~ notify" and
14 inserting in its place the following: 'return them to'

15 Further amend the amendment in Art. IV, Pt. Third, §20 in the 13th line from the end
16 (page 3, line 7 in amendment) by striking out the following: "to retrieve the certified
17 petition forms"

18 SUMMARY

19 This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" by maintaining the provision
20 in the Constitution of Maine requiring the officials to return certified petitions to
21 circulators.
