- Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
- Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and
- Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of state departments and institutions will become due and payable immediately; and
- Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

11 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
