Amend the amendment in section 2 in §1011 in subsection 2 in the 2nd line (page 1,
line 29 in amendment) by striking out the following: "in the State" and inserting the
following: 'located on Indian Island in Penobscot County that is'

federally recognized Indian tribe located on Indian Island.
