If a licensee has reported to the department a violation of chapter 4 or of rules adopted under chapter 4, an enforcement action for civil or administrative penalties brought by the department or the Attorney General for that violation must be initiated within 10 years of the date the licensee reported the violation to the department.

If a licensee has reported to the department a violation of chapter 3, subchapter 1, article 2 or of rules adopted under chapter 3, subchapter 1, article 2, an enforcement action for civil or administrative penalties brought by the department or the Attorney General for that violation must be initiated within 10 years of the date the licensee reported the violation to the department.'

29 30 31 32	This amendment replaces the bill. It requires certain enforcement actions related to air emissions and wastewater discharges to be initiated by the Department of Environmental Protection or the Attorney General's Office within 10 years of the date that the license reported the violation to the department.

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
