## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §347-A, sub-§8 is enacted to read:
- 8. Limitations on enforcement actions. Notwithstanding Title 14, section 752, any enforcement action for civil or administrative penalties brought by the department or the
- 5 Attorney General for a violation of this Title, of rules adopted under this Title or of the
- 6 terms or conditions of a license, permit or order issued by the department must be
- 7 initiated within 5 years of the date of the knowledge by the department or the Attorney
- 8 General of the violation.

9 SUMMARY

- This bill requires enforcement actions for violations of environmental laws to be brought by the Department of Environmental Protection or the Attorney General within 5
- 12 years of the date of knowledge by the department or the Attorney General of the
- 13 violation.
