1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §4011-A is enacted to read:
3	§4011-A. Prohibition on removal of a dog's vocal cords
4 5 6	A person may not remove or have removed a dog's vocal cords except as treatment for a medical condition. A person may not remove or have removed a dog's vocal cord solely to eliminate barking.
