4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill seeks to examine how the governance of the University of Maine System
6 and the Maine Community College System may be combined and consolidated, including
7 a merger of the trustees of the 2 systems, to effectuate a more efficient use of tax dollars
8 and to reduce tuition payments by students.
