COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 149, L.D. 184, Bill, "An Act To Allow a Cosmetologist, Barber, Manicurist or Aesthetician Licensee To Perform Services outside of the Primary Business Location"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 (page 1, lines 2 to 17 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §14203, sub-§2, ¶H, as amended by PL 1997, c. 210, §19, is further amended to read:

H. On persons in their private businesses; and

Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §14203, sub-§2, ¶I, as enacted by PL 1997, c. 210, §20, is amended to read:

I. On human remains in licensed funeral establishments; and

Sec. 3. 32 MRSA §14203, sub-§2, ¶J is enacted to read:

J. On persons at special events with a special event services permit. Services rendered pursuant to this paragraph must be rendered for compensation. A person may not perform special event services without first obtaining a special event services permit from the board. The services provided pursuant to the special event services permit must comply with any applicable public health and safety requirements, the requirements of this chapter and all federal, state and local laws.

Sec. 4. Rules. The Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Office of Licensing and Registration, Board of Barbering and Cosmetology shall adopt rules to implement the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32, section 14203, subsection 2, paragraph J and to specify the types of services that may be performed with a special event services permit. The rules are routine technical rules pursuant to Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

Sec. 5. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

26 **SUMMARY**

27 This amendment replaces the bill and permits a licensed cosmetologist, barber,
 28 manicurist or aesthetician to perform limited services outside of a licensed establishment
 29 if a special event services permit is first obtained from the Department of Professional
 30 and Financial Regulation, Office of Licensing and Registration, Board of Barbering and
 31 Cosmetology. It also directs the board to adopt rules to implement the special event
 32 services permit and to specify the types of services that may be performed by a licensee
 33 with a special event services permit.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes one-time Other Special Revenue Fund allocations of \$8,000 and \$4,500 in fiscal year 2009-10 to the Licensing and Enforcement program and the Administrative Services - Professional and Financial Regulation program, respectively, within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, for the costs associated with allowing a special event services permit to be issued by the Board of Barbering and Cosmetology for licensees to perform limited services outside of a licensed establishment. Sufficient revenues exist within the Board's account to support these one-time costs.
