A newspaper delivery person is not required to be secured in a seat belt while engaged in the actual delivery of newspapers from a vehicle or performing newspaper 14 delivery duties that require frequent entry into and exit from a vehicle.' 15 SUMMARY 16 17 This amendment, which is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on 18 Transportation, clarifies that a newspaper delivery person must be engaged in the actual 19 delivery of newspapers from a vehicle or is performing newspaper delivery duties that 20 require frequent entry into and exit from a vehicle to be exempt from the seat belt 21 requirement in current law.
