1           **Sec. 1. Convene stakeholders group. Resolved:** That the Chancellor of the  
2 University of Maine System and the President of the Maine Community College System  
3 shall convene a stakeholders group to make recommendations to the Legislature and the  
4 Executive Department regarding the role that the University of Maine System and the  
5 Maine Community College System can play in addressing the professional development  
6 needs of state employees. The chancellor and president shall present their  
7 recommendations to the Legislature and the Executive Department by February 15, 2010.
