COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 530, L.D. 779, Bill, "An Act To Require Closed-captioning for Certain Political Advertisements"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 6 in the 11th line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "captioned" the following: 'when closed-captioning is available from the broadcasting station who will broadcast the advertisement'

SUMMARY

The amendment specifies that closed-captioning is required for political advertisements purchased with Maine Clean Election Act funds if closed-captioning is available from the broadcaster of the advertisements.
