2 .	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13407 is enacted to read:
3	§13407. Performance-based salaries
4 5	A salary of a teacher may not be based upon the measurable performance or productivity of the teacher or a student of the teacher.
6	SUMMARY
7 8	This bill prohibits basing teachers' salaries upon the measurable performance or productivity of the teacher or the students of the teacher.
