#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

This amendment would increase the future savings, if the voters approve the Constitutional Amendment. The projected additional savings from a reduction of 4 Senators would be \$172,902 in fiscal year 2014-15 and \$148,015 i fiscal year 2015-16 beginning with the 127th Legislature.
