SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1044, L.D. 1418, Bill, "An Act To Allow Table Games at a Facility Licensed To Operate Slot Machines on January 1, 2011"

Amend the amendment in section 10 in subsection 2-C by striking out all of paragraph C (page 6, lines 9 and 10 in amendment)

Amend the amendment in section 10 in subsection 2-C in paragraph D in the last line (page 6, line 15 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2013." and inserting the following: '2013; and'

Amend the amendment in section 10 in subsection 2-C by inserting after paragraph D the following:


'E. Two percent of net table game income must be forwarded directly to a federally recognized Indian tribe in the State licensed to conduct high-stakes beano on January 1, 2010.'

Amend the amendment in section 10 in subsection 2-C by relettering the paragraphs to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that 2% of net table game income must be forwarded directly to a federally recognized Indian tribe in the State licensed to conduct high-stakes beano on January 1, 2010. It removes the requirement that 2% of net table game income be forwarded directly to the municipality in which the table games are located.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment proposes to eliminate the 2% of net table game income from the Bangor facility distributed to the municipality and instead distribute 2% to a federally recognized Indian tribe. While the total tax remains at 16% of net table game income and the amount of General Fund and Other Special Revenue Funds revenue shown on the committee amendment would not change, the distribution to the municipality would decrease by the amount now distributed to the tribe, \$106,240. The payment from the Bangor facility is contingent upon municipal approval of table games.
