
Amend the bill in Part Z by striking out all of section 2.

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

Under the bill, the scheduled decrease of the Dirigo Health access payment rate from 1.87% to 1.64% between July 1, 2012 and June 30, 2013 is eliminated. This amendment reinstates the scheduled decrease of the Dirigo Health access payment rate.

This amendment eliminates the proposed extension of the current 1.87% Dirigo Health access payment rate through June 30, 2013 and allows the rate to decrease to 1.64% on July 1, 2012 consistent with current law.
