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HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1405, L.D. 1903

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment makes the following technical changes to Committee Amendment "A":

1. It removes the designation of the Public Relations Representative in the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife as a major policy-influencing position and the requirement that the position be appointed by the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife;

It adds the positions of Director, PK-20, Adult Education and Federal Programs
 Team and Director, Special Services Team as major policy-influencing positions in the
 Department of Education, subject to appointment by the Commissioner of Education;

13 3. It provides that the change made to the position of Director, Bureau of
 14 Unemployment Compensation, making it subject to appointment by the Commissioner of
 15 Labor, does not take effect until the position becomes vacant;

16 4. It clarifies that the transfer of the economist positions from the State Planning
17 Office to the Office of Policy and Management takes effect on July 1, 2012;

5. It specifies that the transition provisions transferring employees from the State Planning Office apply to employees who were in those positions as of April 1, 2012; and

6. It specifies that certain functions related to land use planning are transferred to the
 Department of Conservation, instead of the Department of Economic and Community
 Development.
