7	<b>Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §2903, sub-§4,</b> ¶ <b>G</b> is enacted to read:
8 9	G. Bought or used to propel an aircraft that weighs 6,000 pounds or less that is used for commercial aviation.
10	Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act takes effect October 1, 2013.
