**Sec. 1. "Any-deer" hunting permit rule change for veterans with lower limb loss. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall amend Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Rule Chapter 4: Hunting and Trapping to require the issuance of an "any-deer" hunting permit, upon application to the commissioner, to any veteran who has lost all or part of one or more lower limbs, not including a partial foot amputation, in the wildlife management districts that have "anydeer" hunting permit allocations.

**SUMMARY** 

9 This resolve directs the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to amend the 10 hunting and trapping rules to issue an "any-deer" hunting permit to a veteran who has lost 11 all or part of one or more lower limbs for the wildlife management districts that have 12 "any-deer" hunting permit allocations.
