4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	This bill proposes to stabilize state funding for education by requiring the property
6	fiscal capacity component of the essential programs and services funding formula to be
7	based on a rolling 5-year average of the property values of a municipality included in a
8	school administrative unit.
