1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §328 is enacted to read:
3	§328. Former Legislators
4 5	A person who served as a Legislator may not engage in lobbying until one year after that person's term as a Legislator ends.
6 7	Sec. 2. Application. This Act applies to a Legislator who serves in the 126th Legislature or in a later legislature.
8	SUMMARY
9 10 11	This bill prohibits a person who served as a Legislator from lobbying until one year after that person's term as a Legislator ends. It applies to a Legislator who serves in the 126th Legislature or in a later legislature.
