4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5	This bill proposes to ensure that if the Governor curtails funding for the state share of
6	the costs of education the reduction in state funding must be shared equally by all entities
7	receiving public funds for education purposes, including public schools, private schools
8	and charter schools.
