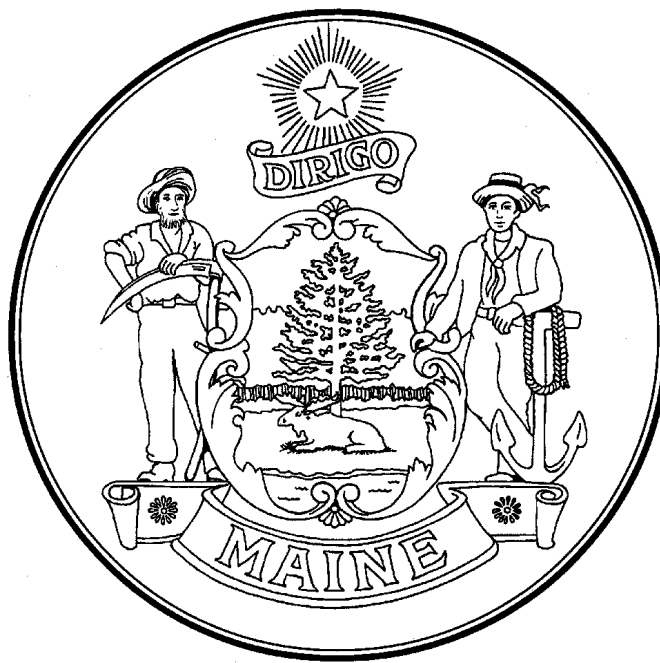

SUMMARY

This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

This bill proposes to amend the school funding formula to require equal funding for each kindergarten to grade 12 student attending Maine public schools based on the pupil counts for April 1st and October 1st for the most recent calendar year.
