Educational institutions, the curriculums of which in whole or in part are registered or approved by the Department of Education, either directly or by acceptance of accreditation by an accrediting body recognized by the Department of Education, and organizations operated by the student bodies of such institutions; and

10	F. Hospitals that are nonprofit and charitable-; and

12 13	<u>G.</u> Incorporated nonprofit health facilities that provide health care to persons at no charge.

15 16	This bill exempts incorporated nonprofit health facilities that provide health care to persons at no charge from licensing requirements under the Charitable Solicitations Act.
