### **An Act To Require Registered Voter Lists To Be Provided to Candidates for Legislative Office**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §196-A, sub-§4** is enacted to read:

**4. Lists provided to candidates for Legislature.** The Secretary of State shall provide a list of registered voters in a legislative district to candidates for the Legislature in that legislative district as follows:

A. Within 10 business days of April 1st during a general election year to candidates who have qualified to be listed on the ballot for the upcoming primary election for either the State Senate or State House of Representatives; and

B. Within 10 business days of July 1st during a general election year to candidates who have qualified to be listed on the ballot for the upcoming general election for either the State Senate or State House of Representatives.

## SUMMARY

This bill requires the Secretary of State to provide lists of registered voters in a legislative district to candidates for the Legislature in that district prior to the primary and general elections.
