11	Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:
12	'An Act To Increase the Age Requirement To Obtain a Concealed Handgun Permit'
13	Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:
14 15	'Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2003, sub-§1, ¶A, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 478, §2, is amended to read:
16 17	A. Is 18 at least 21 years of age or older is a member of any branch of the United States Armed Forces and is at least 18 years of age;'
18 19	Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph D in subparagraph (5) by inserting after division (a) the following:
20 21 22	'(a-1) If your answer to the question in division (a) is "yes," are you a member of any branch of the United States Armed Forces and at least 18 years of age?'
23	SUMMARY
24 25 26 27	This amendment is the majority report and provides that a member of the United States Armed Forces who is at least 18 years of age is eligible to apply for a concealed handgun permit. This is an exception to the proposal in the bill that requires a person to be at least 21 years of age to be eligible to apply for a concealed handgun permit.
