11 12	Amend the bill in section 1 in $2013$ by striking out all of subsection 4 and inserting the following:
13	4. Penalties. The following penalties apply.
14 15	A. A person who violates this section commits a civil violation for which a fine of not more than \$2,500 may be adjudged.
16 17	B. A person who violates this section after having previously violated this section commits a civil violation for which a fine of not more than \$5,000 may be adjudged.'
18	SUMMARY
19 20 21 22 23 24	This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety. The amendment reduces the penalty provision from \$10,000 per violation, instead specifying that a person who violates the background check requirements commits a civil violation for which a fine of not more than \$2,500 may be adjudged for a first violation and a fine of not more than \$5,000 may be adjudged for a 2nd or subsequent violation.
