and Human Services shall amend its rules to increase MaineCare dental reimbursement
rates to the 10th percentile for the following 20 preventive, diagnostic and restorative
dental procedures: D0120, D0140, D0150, D0220, D0272, D0330, D1110, D1120,
D1203, D2140, D2150, D2160, D2330, D2331, D2332, D2391, D2392, D2393, D7140
and D7210.

SUMMARY

8 This resolve increases MaineCare dental reimbursement rates for 20 preventive, 9 diagnostic and restorative dental procedures to the 10th percentile.

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
