## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " to H.P. 244, L.D. 339

### SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the committee. The amendment eliminates the requirement in the bill that a record of a public hearing be accessible to the public on the Legislature's website within 72 hours of the public hearing.

The amendment also eliminates the requirement in the bill that a committee may not hold a work session on a bill unless the public hearing record of the bill is accessible to the public on the Legislature's website. The amendment also removes written transcript and video recording and other electronic recording from the types of records in which the public hearing could be recorded and leaves audio recording as the form for the permanent record.

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes additional General Fund appropriations to the Legislature of \$120,000 in fiscal year 2013-14 and \$12,000 in fiscal year 2014-15 for the estimated cost to contract for storing and posting audio recordings of public hearings of the Legislature on the Internet. The estimated costs may vary from the estimated amounts depending on the method chosen to implement this bill.

Additional costs to the Department of the Secretary of State associated with the State Archivist's assistance to and advisement of the Legislative Council in establishing a records management program for committee public hearings can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
