## 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §3061 is enacted to read:

## 3 §3061. Uniform policy language concerning hurricane deductible programs

4 The superintendent shall adopt rules establishing procedures and standards for an 5 insurer that uses a hurricane deductible program or programs regarding the applicability 6 of hurricane deductibles. Procedures and standards must include without limitation 7 uniform policy language and the form of notice that the insurer must provide to the 8 named insured under a policy subject to this subchapter issued by the insurer. Rules 9 adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined by Title 5, chapter 10 375, subchapter 2-A.

- 11 SUMMARY
- 12 This bill requires the Superintendent of Insurance to adopt routine technical rules 13 concerning the use of hurricane deductibles used in policies subject to the property 14 insurance cancellation control laws.
