HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 310,
L.D. 460, Bill, "An Act To Protect Newborn Infants by Requiring Birthing Facilities To
Screen for Congenital Heart Disease Using Pulse Oximetry"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 2. Existing resources. The Department of Health and Human Services shall
perform its duties under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 1532 within
existing resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment removes from Committee Amendment "A" the requirements that the
Department of Health and Human Services review options for making available to
newborn infants screening for critical congenital heart disease and that the department
report the results of its review to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human
Services by April 1, 2014.
