1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §150-I** is enacted to read:

3 **§150-I. Maine Seniors Day**

4 In recognition of the service and contributions of senior citizens in the State, and for
5 those who continue to enhance the quality of life in the State with their values and
6 experiences, the State designates the 2nd Saturday in September of each year as Maine
7 Seniors Day. The Governor shall annually issue a proclamation urging the people of the
8 State to observe the day with appropriate celebration and activity and encouraging
9 businesses of the State to offer incentives for senior citizens to frequent their
10 establishments.

11 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill establishes the 2nd Saturday in September of each year as Maine Seniors
13 Day to honor senior citizens of the State.
