The working group must include a representative from the Office of the Secretary of State, a representative from a statewide organization focused on voting issues and 2 representatives who are residents of the State; and be it further

Resolved: That, no later than January 30, 2014, the working group shall report the results of the study under section 1 along with any recommended legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local Government.
