1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §439-B, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 593, §2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
4	3. Application. This section does not apply to:
5 6	A. Activities resulting in less than one cubic yard of earth material being added or displaced; and
7	B. Farmers using normal tilling practices.
8	SUMMARY
9 10	This bill provides that the tilling practices of farmers in shoreland areas are not required to be managed by persons certified in erosion control practices.
