1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11229 is enacted to read:
3	<u>§11229. Nonresident sea duck hunting; guide required</u>
4 5 6 7	1. Hunting without a guide. A nonresident may not hunt a sea duck as defined by the commissioner by rule, unless that person hires and is accompanied by a guide holding a valid license issued under chapter 927. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
8 9	<u>2. Penalty.</u> A person who violates subsection 1 commits a civil violation for which a fine of not more than \$500 may be adjudged.

11 This bill requires a nonresident sea duck hunter to hire and be accompanied by a 12 licensed Maine guide.
