Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:	
Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §2736-C, sub-§11 is enacted to read:	
11. Open enrollment. Notwithstanding subsection 3, for individual hare offered outside a health benefit exchange established or operated in the to Section 1311 of the federal Affordable Care Act, a carrier shall:	_
A. Provide an open enrollment period from October 1, 2013 to March	31, 2014;
B. For plan years beginning on or after January 1, 2015, provenrollment period from October 15th to December 7th of the preceding and	
C. Provide special enrollment periods consistent with the requirement open enrollment for health insurance exchanges pursuant to 45 C Regulations, Section 155.420.
