An Act To Allocate the Balance of Funds Not Expended by the Task Force on Franco-Americans

(EMERGENCY)

- 1 **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
- 3 **Whereas,** this legislation authorizes expending funds to offset costs associated with 4 the Legislature's Franco-American Day, which is scheduled this spring; and

5 **Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within 6 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 7 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 8 therefore,

9 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- 10 **Sec. 1. Franco-American Day.** Notwithstanding Resolve 2011, chapter 102 or 11 any other provision of law, the Executive Director of the Legislative Council may retain 12 \$300 in the Task Force on Franco-Americans funding account and expend those funds to 13 offset the costs associated with the Legislature's Franco-American Day.
- 14 **Sec. 2. Payment.** No later than November 1, 2013, the Executive Director of the 15 Legislative Council shall pay \$1,110.50 to the Franco-American Center at the University 16 of Maine, which represents the balance of funds contributed by outside sources to support 17 the work of the Task Force on Franco-Americans established pursuant to Resolve 2011, 18 chapter 102 but not expended by the task force.
- 19 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this
 20 legislation takes effect when approved.
- 21 SUMMARY
- This bill authorizes the Executive Director of the Legislative Council to retain \$300
 in the Task Force on Franco-Americans funding account and expend those funds to offset
 the costs associated with the Legislature's Franco-American Day.
- This bill requires the Executive Director of the Legislative Council to pay \$1,110.50 to the Franco-American Center at the University of Maine, which represents the balance of funds contributed by outside sources to support the work of the Task Force on Franco-Americans, but not expended by the task force, no later than November 1, 2013.
