HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 588,
L.D. 837, Bill, "An Act To Clarify the Laws Establishing the Department of Agriculture,
Conservation and Forestry"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part D the following:

'PART E

Sec. E-1. Legislative intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that curtailments imposed on the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry be imposed proportionally among the major units within the department having substantive jurisdiction over distinct policy areas.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment expresses the Legislature's intent that curtailments imposed upon the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry be imposed proportionally among the major units within the department having substantive jurisdiction over distinct policy areas.
