1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §1, sub-§10, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is 3 amended to read: **10. Elementary school.** "Elementary school" means a public preschool program or 4 that portion of a school that provides instruction in any combination of kindergarten 5 through grade 8. 6 7 Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §1, sub-§23-A, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 141, §2, is 8 amended to read: 9 23-A. Public preschool program. "Public preschool program" means a program offered by a public school or a Head Start agency that provides instruction to children 10 who are 4 years of age. 11 Sec. 3. 20-A MRSA §1, sub-§46 is enacted to read: 12 46. Head Start agency. "Head Start agency" means a program designated as a Head 13 Start agency by the Federal Government under 42 United States Code, Section 9836. 14 **SUMMARY** 15 16 This bill amends the definitions of "elementary school" and "public preschool 17 program" to include federally recognized Head Start agency programs.
