

8	SUMMARY					
9	This amendment removes guardians ad litem appointed under the Maine Revised					
10	Statutes, Title 22 from the provisions covering data reporting, standardized billing and					
11	other administrative requirements. It establishes January 1, 2015 as the effective date for					
12	the provisions of the bill that address the administration of guardians ad litem, the post-					
13	judgment evaluation policy and the reporting requirement. It also replaces the					
14 15	appropriations and allocations section to provide funding for one full-time position and					
15	one part-time position for the Judicial Department.

#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$193,609 in fiscal year 2013-14 and \$121,330 in fiscal year 2014-15. It includes a General Fund appropriation of \$90,000 in fiscal year 2014-15 for the Judicial Department for one Family Process Specialist position and one part-time Administrative Assistant position and related costs to provide oversight of Guardians Ad Litem.
