Report. The Maine Charter School Commission shall submit a report on 15 the review of virtual public charter schools required by section 7 to the joint standing 16 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural affairs no 17 later than December 1, 2014. The report must include the commission's findings and 18 recommendations and any necessary implementing legislation regarding the authorization 19 and operation of virtual public charter schools in the State.
