20 21 22 23 24	This amendment provides rule-making authority to the Superintendent of Consumer Credit Protection for the purpose of administration of the provisions of law regarding employee leasing companies and specifies that rules regarding the ability of the Bureau of Consumer Credit Protection to receive and respond to complaints may be adopted; these rules are designated as routine technical rules.
