11 12	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting the following:
13	'Sec. 1. 27 MRSA §86-B is enacted to read:
14	§86-B. Confidentiality of certain research and personal information
15	1. Draft research and materials, Museum draft research, publications and exhibit
16	materials, including scientific, archaeological and historical findings, are confidential and
17	not public records for the purposes of Title 1, chapter 13, subchapter 1 until complete and
18 19	presented to the public. The Museum Director may authorize disclosure before publication or presentation to the public.
20	2. Personal history research and materials. Personal information contained in any
21	record about the individual that is obtained by the Maine State Museum in the course of a
22	historical research project is confidential and not a public record for the purposes of Title
23	1, chapter 13, subchapter 1 until:
24	A. The individual authorizes the release of the personal information as a public
25	record; or
26	B. The death of the individual, except that the Museum Director may, at the request
27	of the individual, designate in writing that personal information about the individual
28	remain confidential for a specified period, not to exceed 25 years after the death of
29	the individual, to protect the privacy of the individual or the privacy of the parent or
30	child of the individual.
31	For the purposes of this section, "personal information" means any information about
32	an individual's personal history, including, but not limited to, medical, psychiatric,
33	employment, counseling and other information of a personal or private nature.



COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 717, L.D. 1019

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. This amendment:

4 5 6 1. Provides that draft research, publications and exhibit materials of the Maine State Museum are confidential and not public records until publication or presentation to the public or the Museum Director authorizes earlier release; and

2. Provides that personal information obtained by the Maine State Museum in the course of a historical research project is confidential and not a public record until the individual authorizes its release or dies. It also provides that the Museum Director may, at the request of the individual, designate that the information remain confidential for up to 25 years after the death of the individual in order to protect the privacy of the individual or the privacy of the parent or child of the individual.
